## **Responsibilities**



Provide your current health information including medication use, hospitalization and medical history.



Be considerate and respectful of



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Be informed about your treatment, in a way that is understandable.



Personal privacy and confidentiality, regarding treatment and medical records.



Know the names and roles of the people treating you.



Receive treatment as ordered in the dialysis prescription.



Participate in and make decisions about all aspects of your dialysis care.



Bring about any dissatisfaction or complaint without reprisal and have your concerns addressed.



Be informed about the clinics rules and procedures that affect you and feel free to ask questions of staff.

Follow the dialysis clinic rules and procedures.

- - Make every effort to arrive on time for your dialysis appointment time and/or inform the clinic if you may be late or unable to attend.



Stay for the entire dialysis treatment prescribed and/or express your concerns regarding your ability to comply with the treatment.



Report any unexpected changes in your condition.



Make every effort to follow your diet and fluid restrictions for better health.



Ask questions when you do not understand information or instructions.

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
